INTRODUCTION

The assessment and treatment of **traumatic injuries in a hostile environment** pose particular challenges due to the **scarcity of available instrumental resources** and **adverse logistical conditions**.

In the last twenty years, the **experiences of managing traumatized patients in war scenarios** have enabled the development of knowledge concerning damage control surgical techniques and volume re-expansion strategies, which, **transferred to the civilian sphere**, have enhanced a significant reduction of mortality, particularly from haemorrhagic causes.

In these settings, the key elements of the management of the traumatized patient are represented by a **rapid triage**, by the **early use of blood components for volume re-expansion**, by the use of **damage control surgery for a sudden control of haemorrhage and infection**, and by the onward transfer of the patient to facilities equipped with the necessary resources for the definitive treatment of the injuries.

In particular, the optimization of massive transfusion protocols and the early use of blood components on the scene, recently introduced, offer the advantage of **reducing the consequences of trauma-induced coagulopathy**.

The purpose of the "Trauma Update - Trauma Management in Hostile Environments" Conference is to provide, through the participation of national and international faculty with recognized experience in both the military and civilian fields, the most up-to-date knowledge and tools for a **multidisciplinary and systematic approach to the trauma patient in a low resource environment**.
