INTERACTIVE DISCUSSION

In collaborazione con il team dell'Università di Zurigo, siamo lieti di presentare il Polytrauma Course – un corso internazionale che viene organizzato per la prima volta in Italia. Il **Polytrauma Course** è stato ideato per integrare le conoscenze relative al soccorso, al trattamento iniziale ed alla successiva gestione dei pazienti politraumatizzati. Copre quindi un ambito più ampio rispetto ai corsi **ATLS, ETC** o ad altri programmi analoghi. Inoltre, è concepito per favorire la collaborazione tra diverse discipline, tra cui chirurgia viscerale, neurochirurgia, ortopedia e terapia intensiva. Dalla sua ideazione nel 2002, sono stati organizzati oltre **30 corsi** in tutto il mondo.

In collaboration with the University of Zurich team, we are proud to present the **Polytrauma Course** – a renowned international program that we are going to introduce in Italy for the first time.

The **Polytrauma Course** has been designed to combine the knowledge about rescue, initial treatment and the further care of patients with multiple injuries. It therefore covers a larger spectrum than **ATLS, ETC or other courses**. Moreover, it is thought to bring together multiple disciplines, including visceral surgeons, neurosurgeons, orthopedic surgeons, and intensivists. The Polytrauma Course has been validated since 2014 and is accredited according to ISO standards. Since its development in 2002, **more than 30 international courses** have been organized world wide.

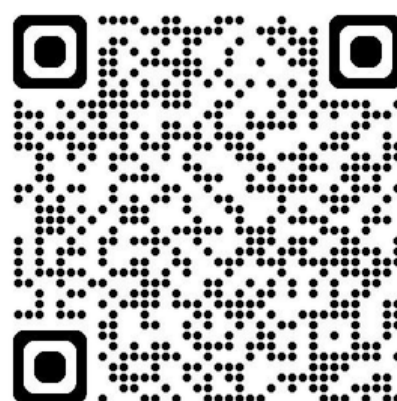
